There are more than 900 student clubs and organizations at Iowa State University. Learning communities at Iowa State have served more than 78,000 students, while the placement rate for jobs or continuing education six months after graduation is 94%.

19,022 Iowa residents were enrolled at ISU during fall 2018 including:

- 4,371 students in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences
- 4,113 students in the College of Engineering
- 3,208 students in College of Agriculture and Life Sciences
- 2,909 students in the College of Human Sciences
- 2,909 students in the College of Business
- 1,109 students in the College of Design
- 301 Veterinary Medicine students
- 102 students in Interdepartmental Studies
- 5,269 Iowa students were on ISU's 2018 Spring Honor Roll

Each year ISU Extension and Outreach directly benefits more than one million people and is responsible for more than five million educational interactions. Iowa State University's science-focused business assistance program is a key problem solver for businesses in Iowa. The Center for Industrial Research and Service (CIRAS) provided engineering services to 1,705 businesses across the state last year.

The Small Business Development Center (SBDC) serving Iowa assisted 4,180 clients last year, helping to create or retain 1,233 jobs and start 205 new businesses.
