Iowa State University's impact in Taylor County

25 Taylor County residents are enrolled at ISU including:

- 2 students in the College of Veterinary Medicine
- 2 students in the College of Business
- 8 Taylor County students were on ISU's 2018 Spring Honor Roll

116 ISU Alumni reside in Taylor County including:

- 3 Engineers

- 1 in Banking/Finance

557 Taylor County residents enrolled in educational offerings and an estimated 1,700 directly benefited from interactions with ISU Extension and Outreach – covering the entire lifespan, from our youngest to oldest Iowans. We're focused on feeding people, keeping them healthy, empowering communities, and turning the world over to the next generation better than we found it. That's how we're building a strong Iowa.

Iowa State University's science-focused business assistance program is a key problem solver for Taylor County businesses. The Center for Industrial Research and Service (CIRAS) provided engineering services to 1 business last year.

The Small Business Development Center (SBDC) serving Taylor County assisted 19 clients last year, helping to create or retain 6 jobs and start 2 new businesses.
