Iowa State University's impact in Jones County

67 Jones County residents are enrolled at ISU including:

- 26 students in the College of Agriculture and Life Science
- 17 students in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences
- 13 students in the College of Engineering
- 8 students in the College of Business
- 6 students in the College of Human Sciences
- 3 students in Interdepartmental Studies
- 1 student in the College of Design
- 1 student in the College of Veterinary Medicine
- 20 Jones County students were on ISU's 2017 Spring Honor Roll

430 ISU Alumni reside in Jones County including:

- 45 in Agriculture
- 32 Engineers
- 16 Pre K/K-12 Educators
- 7 Veterinarians
- 5 in Banking/Finance
- 1 Architects

1,400 Jones County residents enrolled in educational offerings and an estimated 4,200 directly benefited from interactions with ISU Extension and Outreach – covering the entire lifespan, from our youngest to oldest Iowans. We're focused on feeding people, keeping them healthy, empowering communities, and turning the world over to the next generation better than we found it. That's how we're building a strong Iowa.

Iowa State University's science-focused business assistance program is a key problem solver for Jones County businesses. The Center for Industrial Research and Service (CIRAS) provided engineering services to 5 businesses last year.

The Small Business Development Center (SBDC) serving Jones County assisted 17 clients last year, helping to create or retain 5 jobs and start 1 new business.
