Iowa State University's impact in Scott County

720 Scott County residents are enrolled at ISU including:

- 227 students in the College of Engineering
- 144 students in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences
- 116 students in the College of Human Sciences
- 88 students in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences
- 88 students in the College of Business
- 44 students in the College of Design
- 10 students in the College of Veterinary Medicine
- 3 students in Interdepartmental Studies
- 231 Scott County students were on ISU's 2018 Spring Honor Roll

3,233 ISU Alumni reside in Scott County including:

- 365 Engineers
- 119 Pre K/K-12 Educators
- 69 in Agriculture
- 42 in Banking/Finance
- 37 Veterinarians
- 26 Architects

6,455 Scott County residents enrolled in educational offerings and an estimated 19,200 directly benefited from interactions with ISU Extension and Outreach – covering the entire lifespan, from our youngest to oldest Iowans. We're focused on feeding people, keeping them healthy, empowering communities, and turning the world over to the next generation better than we found it. That's how we're building a strong Iowa.

Iowa State University's science-focused business assistance program is a key problem solver for Scott County businesses. The Center for Industrial Research and Service (CIRAS) provided engineering services to 148 businesses last year.
